Our roads and rail systems are built with both the modern consumer and modern production facility in mind; providing the infrastructure needed to keep logistics streamlined and transportation times to a minimum.

## **ROADWAYS**

#### **Interstates**

- Interstate 795- north/south interstate connecting Goldsboro to US Hwy 264; providing direct access to Greenville to the east and Wilson, I-95, and I-40 to the west
- Interstate 95- north/south interstate that runs the length of the US east coast, allowing the transportation of goods to Maine or Miami in 12 hours
- Interstate 40- east/west interstate that spans the southern USruns east coast to west coast, with access within 5 miles of Mount Olive, NC

# **US Highways**

- **US Hwy 13** used frequently as a transportation route for trucking companies, spans from eastern Wayne County to the south-west; serves as a feeder highway for US Hwy 117, US Hwy 70 and all major interstates
- **US Hwy 117** major thoroughfare connecting the county's largest industrial facilities to transport goods and raw materials; provides northbound access to I-95 via I-795 and provides direct access to I-40 outside of Mount Olive
- **US Hwy 70** key east/west route that connects eastbound to the coast and deepwater ports and westbound to Raleigh and Raleigh-Durham International Airport; direct access to I-795 and I-40

## **NC Highways**

- NC 111- feeder highway connecting southeastern portions of Wayne County to US Hwy 70 in the north and I-40 in the south
- NC 581- highway beginning in downtown Goldsboro, connecting to Hwy 70 (business and bypass);
  provides direct access to I-95 and US Hwy 301
- NC 222- provides northern portions of Wayne County with direct access to I-795 and I-95
- NC 55- connects Wayne County's southwestern area to US Hwy 117 and I-40

### **RAILROADS**

- CSX- major railway through Wayne County, parallel to I-795/US Hwy 117 corridor; providing access to north/south markets along I-95 and east/west access via I-40
- Norfolk Southern- major railway serving Wayne County, running parallel to major eastwest US Hwy 70; providing direct access to I-40, US Hwy 117 and the deep water port at Morehead City, NC

#### **PORTS**

- **NC Port at Wilmington** 2 hours distant; direct rail line from Goldsboro; offers container, bulk and break-bulk service; 42 foot navigational channel; Foreign Trade Zone #66
- NC Port at Morehead City- one of the deepest ports on the US east coast; break-bulk and bulk cargo, dry bulk warehouse capacity; access via I-95 and I-40 as well as U.S. Hwy 70 and Hwy 17
