DecisionData Resources Instructions

Below we have developed general instructions for gathering certain data points using the DecisionData Resources website and service. This service does not include all of the data points tracked in this project. It pertains only to the following data points:

- Percentage of Young People (25-44)
- Percentage of Mature Age Population (65+)
- Per Capita Income
- Median household Income
- Income by Age groups 25-44 and 65+ (additional Instructions below on page 10)
- Labor Force and Unemployment (additional Instructions below on page 10)
- Educational Attainment

The instructions on attaining this data from traditional sources (i.e. Census) is still contained in this Instruction Manual below should there be a future unforeseen need to access this data from the Census.

- 1) Click on "Client Login" in upper right hand corner of site
- 2) Enter Username and Password
- 3) Geography selection: Select Counties, then continue
- 4) Select North Carolina, then continue
- 5) Select each of the 13 counties, pressing the arrow button to move each county into the right hand column. Once all 13 counties are selected press continue
- 6) In the "Standard Report" tab, select "Comparison"
- 7) Scroll down and select "Demographic Detail", press "View Selected Report"
- 8) The report will now be displayed with all 13 counties. From this, select "Make Excel" to make the report an Excel spreadsheet. Save the spreadsheet to your computer.
- 9) Once the spreadsheet is saved, all of the above data points are readily accessible for each county. For the percentage of young people, just sum the two categories "Age 15-34" and "Age 35-44"

- 10) Click on 2001 forward (NAICS basis)
- 11) Select State (North Carolina)
- 12) Select one or more Areas (Carteret, Craven, Duplin, Edgecombe, Greene, Jones, Lenior, Nash, Onslow, Pamlico, Pitt, Wayne, & Wilson)
- 13) Select one or more Industries (Total, all Industries)
- 14) Select one or more Ownerships (Private)
- 15) Select one or more Establishment Sizes (All Establishment Sizes)
- 16) Select one or more Data Types (Number of Establishments)
- 17) Click on the 'Add to Your Selection →' button
- 18) Click on the 'Get Data' button

The data will appear in a new window.

- 19) Click on "More Formatting Options"
- 20) Specify year range: (2004) to (2005)
- 21) Select one time period: (Annual Data)

To determine the number of new establishments, subtract the number of establishments in the later year from the number of years in the former year. While this methodology isn't perfect (it fails to take into account closing businesses), it is the best means of approximating economic trends using publicly available data.

- 9) Click on 'Download' button

An excel file will open up. To determine the number of establishments with fewer than 10 employees, aggregate the number of firms with 0 to 4 employees and the number of firms with 5 to 9 employees. Again, steps 5 through 9 must be repeated separately for each county.

Perform this task in likewise manner to determine employment in medium sized businesses (size 10-49). This also will require aggregating firms with employment of 10 to 19 and firms with employment of 20 to 49. These steps must also be repeated separately for each county.

Available data is listed by year, with the most recently available data listed first. 2004 is currently the most recent year in which data on the number of graduate students and postdoctorates in science and engineering is available.

The data only covers the following schools in North Carolina--Appalachian State University, Duke University, East Carolina University, NC Agricultural and Technical State University, North Carolina Central University, North Carolina State University, UNC at Chapel Hill, UNC at Charlotte, UNC at Greensboro, UNC at Wilmington, Wake Forest University, and Western Carolina University. For the purposes of the North Carolina Eastern Region, East Carolina University is the most important academic institution.

- 1) For 2004 data, click on Graduate Students and Postdoctorates in S&E: Fall 2004 [NSF 06-325].
- 2) Open up the PDF file under Downloads, to the right of 'all detailed statistical tables.'

Tables 30 and 31 have the information on the number of graduate science and engineering students in all institutions, by region, state, institution, and citizenship, and by race/ethnicity of U.S. citizens and permanent residents for year 2004. This data must be copied from the PDF document into an Excel file to be manipulated.

- 1) For 2003 data, click on Graduate Students and Postdoctorates in S&E: Fall 2003 [NSF 06-307]
- 2) Open up the PDF file under Downloads, to the right of 'all detailed statistical tables.'

Tables 30 and 31 have the information on the number of graduate science and engineering students in all institutions, by region, state, institution, and citizenship, and by race/ethnicity of U.S. citizens and permanent residents for year 2003. This data must be copied from the PDF document into an Excel file to be manipulated.

Percentage of Young People (Age 25-44)

The American Community Survey (ACS) provides data on all geographic areas with populations in excess of 65,000. As such, less than half of the counties in the North Carolina Eastern Region are included in the ACS; data is available for Craven County, Nash County, Onslow County, Pitt County, Wayne County, and Wilson County. In 2010, after the next census is taken, it is likely that several more counties in the Eastern Region will have the requisite populations to be included in the ACS. These counties are Carteret (59,383), Lenoir (59,648), and Edgecombe (55,606). Population numbers are based on the 2000 census.

Income By Age Groups 25-44 and 65+

This data will be accumulated on the Decision Data Resources website resource.

- 1) Go to Decision Data Resources and select geography (13 counties)
- Select the 'Income By Age' Standard report. Incomes will be only listed in \$10,000 increments by Age.
- 3) Aggregate the 25-34 and the 35-44 Age groups for each income group. Do the same for the 64-75 Age group and the 75+ age group for each income group.
- 4) Normalize all income groups by dividing by that Age groups total population (i.e. divide number of people in each income level in the 25-44 age group by total 25-44 age population. Do the same for each in the 65+ age group)
- 5) Sum the percentages of individuals below \$40,000 for both the 25-44 age group and the 65+ Age group.
- 6) Sum the percentages of individuals above the \$75,000 for both the 25-44 age group and the 65+ Age group.
- 7) For comparison purposes, the same steps should be followed for the U.S. and the State of North Carolina.

Labor Force and % Unemployment

This data will be accumulated on the Decision Data Resources website resource.

- 1) Go to Decision Data Resources and select geography (13 counties)
- 2) In the "Standard Reports' tab click on 'Make a new custom summary report".
- 3) Select Occupations and Employment. Select 'Current Year Estimates (2006)'
- Select the following variables: % Civilian Unemployed, %Civilian Unemployed Index, Civilian Unemployed, In Labor Force.
- 5) Repeat Step 4 for US Census 2000 data.
- 6) Save this report with name of your choice. This report will now appear in the Standard tab. You can view and save this report just as the others.
- 7) Download the data into the Excel spreadsheet and manipulate as needed.



Educational Attainment

The American Community Survey (ACS) provides data on all geographic areas with populations in excess of 65,000. As such, less than half of the counties in the North Carolina Eastern Region are included in the ACS; data is available for Craven County, Nash County, Onslow County, Pitt County, Wayne County, and Wilson County. In 2010, after the next census is taken, it is likely that several more counties in the Eastern Region will have the requisite populations to be included in the ACS. These counties are Carteret (59,383), Lenoir (59,648), and Edgecombe (55,606). Population numbers are based on the 2000 census.
