Business incubator granted loan

North Carolina's Eastern Region has awarded the County of Wilson a loan for the amount of \$100,000 to assist the county in the completion of the business incubator project.

The project belongs to the Upper Coastal Plain Council of Governments, which will relocate to the incubator's fourth floor from its current office in Rocky Mount.

Money for this 15-year loan from North Carolina's Eastern Region will be disbursed from a dedicated fund created to support economic development in the 13-county Eastern Region.
